EQUIPMENT:

Tape measure Cones hoops bean bags throw-down strips

Score cards

Set up: Split children up into 6 groups

- Rotate around the stations.
- Score only on the Shuttle run station 1, if you are entering the 'Worlds fastest school competition'

Station 1: 5 x Runs (2 x cones- 10 metres apart)

RECORD THIS SCORE ON TO INTER SCHOOL COMPETITION SCORE CENTRE SHEET



- 1. Place the cones 10 metres apart.
- 2. **One child** to run at a time and complete 5 runs = 50m
- 3. Time how long it takes to complete 5 runs











Station 2: Target throw (1 beanbag per child,1 throw-down strip,1 red hoop,1 yellow hoop,1 Green hoop)

1. Children take it in turns at throwing their bean bag into a hoop.



Station 3: Standing long jump (1 throw-down strip,1 red cone,1 yellow cone,1 green cone)

- 1. Cones to be placed 0.5m apart.
- 2. Team to line up behind the throw-down strip.
- 3. Each member of the team is to take it in turns to jump as far as they can.











Station 4: Egg and spoon (As a team-1 racket, 2 cones and 1 ball, or if individual 1 racket and ball each)

- 1 Place the 2 cones 5m apart.
- 1. Children to line up behind each other
- 2. Children to balance the egg and spoon/ tennis ball on the racket.



Note: All the children could work at once, each with a racket and a ball.

Station 5: Superhero arm (1 throw-down strip, 3 red cones, 3 yellow cones, 3 green cones, 1 ball

1. Each child takes a turn at throwing the object as far as they can.











Objects you can use: beanbags, javelin or a tennis ball (depending on space)

Station 6: Goal Fun

- 1. One child at a time to kick the ball into a target.
- 2. If they get it through the cones they earn 1 point, if they get it in the corners they earn 2 points.
